SAFETY RULES & INFORMATION:

General:

- *If you open a gate, you must close a gate.

Riding:

- *Ride at your own risk.
- *You must sign a release before riding.
- *Riders under 18 years of age must be accompanied by a guardian or an instructor.
- *Riders must wear protective head gear.
- *Boots with heels must be worn when riding.
